And with the 2016 elections fast approaching, there may also be a tendency on the part of some patriotic Americans to consider entering the fray, if not on a national level, then certainly on a state or local one. In fact, for the first time in many years, opportunities may abound for the election of virtual unknowns to many seats of power throughout the fruited plain. Americans are tired of the recycling of the same compromising, do-nothing, sell-out politicians year after election year. As evidenced by the large number of GOP hats already in the Republican Primary ring, people are ready for real change in our nation. Train up your flocks, pastors, so that they will then be educated to properly choose a candidate to vote for. Less than half of the 80 million people who claim to be evangelical in America are registered to vote. And of those, many remain on the sideline on Election Day because Jesus isn't on the ballot. Light a fire under your congregations, pastors, so that we can effect a grass roots change in our country. But do it from your pulpit, not a state or federal office building. "Another Jesus" Calling Part II – Contemplative Meditation and False Christs

"For if he that cometh preacheth <u>ANOTHER JESUS</u> ... another spirit ... or another gospel ... For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ. And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light ... his ministers ... as the ministers of righteousness ... (2 Cor. 11:4, 13-15).

"What shall be the sign ... of the end of the world ... Jesus answered ... many shall come in MY NAME, saying I am Christ; and shall deceive many" (Matt. 24:1-5).

Warren B. Smith, author, teacher and conference speaker, was formerly a follower in the New Age movement. Now a Christian, Warren has written extensively on the subject of spiritual deception and has spoken on radio, television and at seminars and conferences. All his eye-opening publications are available through Lighthouse Trails Publishing.

Smith relates in his book, "Another Jesus" Calling, that he first became alarmed by Sarah Young's book, "Jesus Calling" in 2013. It troubled him to read that Young claimed to be receiving personal messages from "Jesus." Young admitted that this began after she had read "God Calling," a book Warren knew well as a book that was "channeled," which is an ancient occult practice revived in New Age circles.

Having been deeply involved in the Occult/New Age culture and being delivered out of it by God's evangel of Grace, Smith became deeply concerned after reading "Jesus Calling" because Warren found it presented New Age practices and concepts as being completely normal for Christians. Worse, he said, it contained no warnings. Warren indicated that Young's "Jesus" had subtly introduced Occult/New Age channeling, spiritual dictation, creative visualization, meditation, divine alchemy, co-creation with God and "Practicing the Presence," like it was everyday fare. Warren's conclusion was that "Jesus Calling" seemed to be "an obvious attempt by our spiritual adversary to get an even further foothold inside the Christian church."

When the Lord warned of counterfeit Christs (Matt. 24:1-5), He was not speaking only of charlatans like Waco's David Koresh or The People's Temple's Jim Jones; men too unbelievable for most people who could not accept their false claims of divinity.

What the deadly adversary of men's souls really prefers is to remain in the shadows in the greater more subtle deceptions in the world <u>AND</u> in the church right now – a deception of voices purporting to be "Jesus," or "God," or the "Holy Spirit" – speaking through books, during seekers quiet times of meditation, contemplative prayer times and while "Practicing the Presence." Our foe's evil plan from the beginning was for his "seed," the counterfeit Christ (Gen. 3:15) to one day introduce new revelations of a New Age/New World religion (Rev. 17) to a troubled world desperately seeking answers.

Just as scripture warns that there are the pleasures of "sin for a season" (Heb. 11:25) so those saved out of the occult and the New Age warn that spiritual experiences that come in the name of "Jesus" are not necessarily from <u>Him</u> – experiences that can feel "wonderful and uplifting," while actually being deception and evil from the "prince of the power of the air" (Ep. 2:2-3), the seducing spirits (1 Tim. 4:1) that should always be "tested" (1 John 4:1-3) to make absolutely certain that what anyone experiences spiritually is from the only true and living God. Every born-again child of God (Ep. 1:3-4) can quench the devil's darts (Ep. 6:16) and cause him to flee (James 4:7) when calling on the true Jesus' name and quoting God's Word (John 3:16 et al.) "for greater is he that is in you than he that is in the world" (1 John 4:4).

It is not just a friendly suggestion when scripture challenges <u>every</u> Christian to "study to show thyself approved of God ... rightly dividing the word of truth ... and to know also that in the last days perilous times shall come..." (2 Tim. 2:15, 3:1) ...when "they will <u>NOT</u> endure sound doctrine ... and shall be turned unto fables..." (2 Tim. 4:3-4). It is a command that we are <u>NOT</u> to be ignorant of Satan's devices (2 Cor. 2:11) but rather to do as the Bereans (Acts 17:1) and making absolutely certain we are in the true faith (2 Cor. 13:5) and to be sure the <u>VOICE</u> we are asked to follow of man <u>OR</u> spirit is not that of a seducing counterfeit shepherd (John 10:4-5).

Since "Jesus Calling" became an international best seller (over 10 million copies) Warren B. Smith saw the imperative to examine the book that started Sarah Young on the path that led to "Jesus Calling." That book was the channeled New Age book, "God Calling." Warren listed only some of his many concerns by an occult book influencing the heritage of God.

Of course, Smith first addressed the fact that "God Calling" was composed by an occult channeling process known as spiritual dictation. The messages in this "Daily Devotional" was channeled by two women in England in 1937. They chose to remain anonymous and were simply called, "Two Listeners." They claimed their source was Christ Himself so their book could have been also called "Jesus Calling." Sarah Young said that "God Calling" gave her the desire to receive messages during meditation and eventually "Jesus" gave her the messages that became "Jesus Calling."

There is a 39 chapter warning about occult channeling in the "Encyclopedia of New Age Beliefs" that labels it Mediumship – forbidden in Scripture (Deut. 18:9-12). "God Calling" is cited as being a New Age channeled book, one filled with denials of biblical teachings – dangerous for Christians.

Warren noted the New Age terminology in "God Calling," such as: Universal Spirit, Supreme Being, Divine Powers, Spiritual Forces, God-Power, spiritual plane, channels, Spirit-Consciousness, Spirit Communication, Secret of Prosperity, Law of Supply, Sonship, spiritual level, oneness, among many others. These truths laced with deceptive corruptions are communicated to "seekers" through "inner voices," "whispers," spiritual dictation, automatic writing, channeling, and more.

In a follow-up book to "God Calling" – "God at Eventide," "Jesus" states: "You are not to know any differences of race, color (fine so far), or creed." The latter is contrary to scripture (Mark 13:21-22; 2 Cor. 6:14-18; Ep. 5:11; 1 Tim. 4:1-2). The "God Calling" "Jesus" claimed

oneness and unity of God and man and man to man. The Jesus of scripture taught the contrary (Matt. 10:34-36). Jesus taught the narrow way, not universalism (Matt. 7:13-14).

The occult/New Age teaching is that God is in everyone as does the "Jesus" of "God Calling." The God of the Bible does NOT universally reside in every person which is why Christ told Nicodemus, "Ye must be born again" (John 3:5-8). Only then does the Holy Spirit dwell in us (John 14:16-17). That man is in any way divine is an ancient lie (Gen. 3:5).

The Bible teaching from the true Jesus is to pray that <u>GOD'S</u> will be done. "God Calling," using the same health, wealth and happiness, name it and claim it false teaching that slithers out of cable TV's "religious channels," suggest that man can have <u>his will</u> be done by "speaking the word." This "create your own reality teaching" is a basic New Age/occult concept called "The Law of Manifestation," allegedly achieved by "creative visualization." God holds all these occult concepts in contempt and promises judgment upon practitioners (Deut. 18:10-12).

"God Calling" elevates spiritual experiences over God's written Word allowing deception to fill the vacuum. Absurdities appear in "God Calling" – "Jesus needs us more than we need Him," "Jesus will introduce new truths" because "man's thoughts of me need revolutionizing," and man should "cultivate the silence" and "meet Jesus in the silence" to name a few.

"God Calling" deceptively weaves Christian terminology with a masking of leaven to appear plausible (Gal. 5:7-9). For Sarah Young to describe "God Calling" as "a treasure to me" and to recommend it is incomprehensible. Her book, "Jesus Calling" picks up where "God Calling" left off according to Smith. Now, both "God Calling" and "Jesus Calling" are bringing occult meditative practices, channeling and spiritual dictation to the attention of Christians and hence into the church. The antidote is to "seek to know the truth" (John 8:31-32, 14:6).

In the 21st Century, false teachers have come into the visible church like a flood (Is. 59:19). Thankfully, Christian researchers, like Warren B. Smith, have provided tools for Christians to raise a standard for God's true Savior, our Lord Jesus Christ and to equip believers to be "Watchmen on the Wall" as we see "that Day approaching" (Heb. 10: 24-25).
